Sub: Extension of Provisional Affiliation to the above said school beyond 31.03.2015.

Sir/Madam,


With reference to your online application dated 26/06/2014 on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey sanction of extension of provisional affiliation of the school with the Board for its Secondary School Examination and Senior School Certificate Examination for a further period of Five years w.e.f. 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2020 subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions in addition to the general conditions intimated at the time of grant of provisional affiliation for secondary and senior secondary classes :-

1. The School is required to follow syllabi and course as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for the respective Examination.
2. The School is required to abide itself by the Examination/Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board.
3. The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation alongwith the requisite fee and other documents by 30th June of the preceding year in which the Provisional Affiliation expires. Applications will be accepted after the last date along with the prescribed fee and late fee Rs. 10,000/- per month.(Amended Rule 15.11)
4. Provisional Affiliation granted to a school will remain valid on receipt of online application of a school for further extension of provisional affiliation subject to the final decision of the Board.(Amended Rule 15.11)
5. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
6. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII :-

7. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.
8. Income & Expenditure and audited annual accounts statement duly certified by the Chartered Accountant for the current year is required to be sent and the same be submitted every year.
9. Other conditions are enclosed as per Annexure 'A'.
10. **Special conditions to be complied within three months:-**
 - a) As per Amended rule - 10.2 of chapter II in affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board, the salary should now be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.
 - b) The school is also required to furnish valid Sanitary Conditions, Drinking Water and Fire Safety Certificates issued by the competent authorities.
 - c) The School Managing Committee has not been constituted as per Affiliation Bye-laws, therefore, it may be reconstituted by including 02 representatives each of teachers, parents and CBSE. The school is required to forward a panel of 5-6 names of persons (at least 2 from KVS/JNV) not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee.
 - d) The school is required to ensure that pay-scales, DA and other admissible allowances are being paid to all the staff members at par with the corresponding categories of employees working in the State/Central Govt. Schools. Also photocopy of acquaintance roll of latest month duly signed by all recipients and a certificate from the Bank to this effect are required to be submitted.
 - e) The school is required to purchase more books as per the norms of the Board.
 - f) The school is required to furnish an affidavit in original sworn in before the first class magistrate to the effect that the school is not sponsoring candidates of any other school/Board in the Board examination.
 - g) The enrolment of students in many sections is high. Hence, the school is strictly advised to maintain optimum number of 40 students in each section as per norms.
